Venue

IJCAI-17 will be held at the **Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre (MCEC)**, located at 1 Convention Centre Pl, South Wharf. Recognized as Australasia's leading meetings and conference centre from 2012 - 2015 by the prestigious World Travel Awards, Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre (MCEC) is located next to the Yarra River in South Wharf, an inner-city suburb of Melbourne, and is within walking distance of the premier attractions such as Federation Square, Collins Street, National Gallery of Victoria, the Docklands, the Royal Botanic Gardens, and many other iconic Melbourne landmarks.

IJCAI-17 will use the ground floor and the 2nd floor of the MCEC. The **exhibits** will be on the main foyer on the ground level near the coffee breaks. The nearby location of the coffee breaks will serve to maximize participation and interest in the exhibits.

Scope

Based on previous IJCAI conferences, we expect an attendance of over 1000 participants, drawn from the world's top technical universities, research labs and applied industry firms.

The IJCAI technical standards are very high. Typically, only about 25% of submitted papers are selected for oral or poster presentation at IJCAI. This means that our participants are drawn from the world's best AI experts.

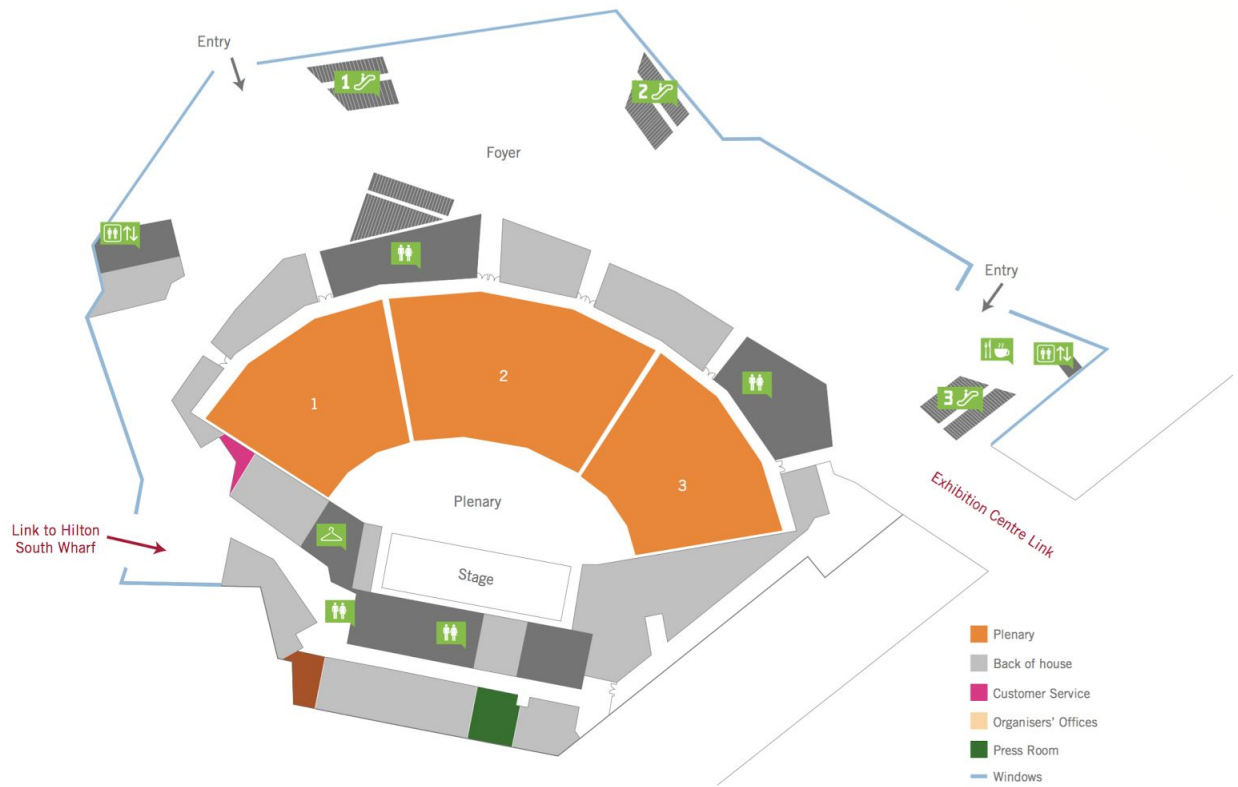
